- III. Mr. Trujillo discussed the purpose of the ELAC meeting which was to talk about the ELAC committee and the services the school offers to EL students. Mr. Trujillo went over what ELAC means and explained its purpose to the students and parents.
- IV. Mr. Trujillo introduced EL paraprofessionals Avigail Sotelo and Denisse Campo Lizama
- V. Avigail Sotelo and Denisse Campo Lizama introduced themselves and talked about their schedules and contact information.
- VI. Ms. Martinez, the school counselor, introduced herself and talked about contact information and schedule. She talked about how she provides support for students and told students how to schedule an appointment with her. Ms. Martinez talked about graduation and other important information students need to know.
- VII. Mr. Trujillo talked about English Learner Reclassification and what it means for the students. He explained the process and how students can reclassify. Mr. Trujillo presented

- an award for classification to Diego Pascual Gaspar for reclassifying. He went over the criteria and explained state testing, NWEA, and English classes.
- VIII. Mr. Trujillo talked about the SGI classes we offer and what teachers teach those classes. English (M &. W) is taught by Mr. Fresques, ELD and Rosetta Stone (M & W) is taught by Ms. Calderon and Ms. Campo, Personal Finance (T & Tr) is taught by Mrs. Lopez, and Biology B (T & Tr) is taught by Mrs. Martin
- IX. Mr. Trujillo talked about testing and went over each test. The first test is the NWEA The NWEA MAP Test (Measures of Academic Progress) is an adaptive achievement and growth test. It creates a personalized assessment experience by adapting to each student's learning level—precisely measuring progress and growth for each individual student. The second test is the initial ELPAC which is used to identify students as being either an English learner or fluent English proficient. It is administered only once during a student's time in the California public school system, based on the results of the home language survey. The locally scored Initial ELPAC is the official score. The final test that was discussed was the Summative ELPAC. The Summative English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) is an annual assessment to measure an English learner's progress toward English language proficiency (ELP). Mr. Trujillo informed students and parents that we were currently in the testing season and we are testing Tuesdays and Thursdays. Mr Trujillo reminded students and parents to be mindful of the dates they are scheduled to test and emphasized best practices for testing.
