Ms. Sinopoli introduced herself, welcomed all in-person and virtual attendees. She gave brief overview of Agenda items on PowerPoint that will be discussed and introduced Mr. Colin Opseth who would be sharing more information.

> Mr. Opseth, Federal & State Programs Coordinator, spoke on the following Items with PowerPoint Visual as guide

**LCAP Update-** with support from administration and parent/student feedback- how monies will be spent and evaluated yearly, LCAP Report on school website, public information – please take parent/student survey21-22 Title I Program- VN received 9.3 million- 205million in supplemental funding, this can be used for anything needed, need to spend funding on Fieldtrips

**SARC**- School Accountability Report Card, issued yearly based on information provided by school at end of school year, tells the State how we are doing for year prior- can be found online and at the front desk of school office. Information that can be found in report also includes Student Population, Curriculum accessibility, Teacher Assignments, School status of facilities, Drop Out Rate and Graduation rate, State testing reports, Absenteeism *(Mr. Opseth:* Teachers will be on-site full time in the next couple of weeks this should help improve absenteeism, overall improvement)

## **GRANTS Update:**

- Learning Recovery Emergency Block Grant- received 1.3 million and can be used over the next couple of years
- Educator Effectiveness Block Grant-received smaller amount for VistaNorte- has been used for 1<sup>st</sup> Aid testing. Training on dangers of Fentanyl and a portion used for recent Regional PD
- Arts, Music, and Instruction Grants-\$430 thousand awarded to Vista Norte to be used over the next couple of years, can be used for professional development COVID items (PPE, testing kits), looking into a school library for recreational reading /Spanish books

Mr. Opseth asked if there were any questions/ no questions presented. Encouraged attendees to reach out if they would like to discuss budget in person or over the phone. Links were put in Chat Box

> Ms. Mallozzi, Assistant Principal, spoke on the following items:

**CTE/ Dual Enrollment(DE)-** Courses offered vary, currently working with Chaffey College, so far this year 700 credits completed but looking forward to an improvement in the next year. Although exceeding goal as a region

**Graduation and Field Trips-** VistaNorte has graduated 13 students as of today; what can we do to get student reengaged/ motivated? Attendees encouraged to provide feedback/ Item can be discussed further as well

**2022-23 Graduation Ceremony**- will take place on June 2<sup>nd</sup> at the 66ers Stadium in San Bernardino more information to come

Grad-Nite /Universal Studios: will take place on May 25th 2023- please see school counselor for more info

**Testing/EL Reclassification Update/ Home Study Update-** testing season has started, PFT-CAASSP- ELPAC , Upcoming State Testing-very important that students take all testing seriously and do their best

- 4 out 5 students eligible to reclassify have reclassified, currently monthly reclassification process in place instead of twice a year- this is a positive change to increase mindfulness to help EL student population
- Home Study Program total enrollment 241 students (Rialto : 216, Casa Blanca 25)
